Language Level Requested

B2 (proficient intermediate user) French according to the CERCL - If program is French-speaking or partly French-speaking.

French as a Foreign Language (FLE) are offered for free by the University.

3 hours per week that is to say 30 class-hours per semester.

Year-long students may enroll in and receive credit for the course both semesters.

International Student Integration

Housing	Once accepted, students have the opportunity to request accommodation in public university housing through Lyon 1 (250-450€/month). Due to limited availability, not all requests may be granted. If the student is interested in other option, he can look for a flat with the platform at Lyon 1 : <u>Studapart</u> (where he could have a guarantor)	
Insurances	Students must have health, civil liability, and renter's insurance valid in France. Exchange students are eligible for free health insurance. For more information : <u>Sécurité sociale française (</u> Zip code : 69008)	
Cost of living	Estimated monthly budget : 900€.	
Students with disabilities	Lyon 1 has a dedicated service, <u>Mission Handicap</u> , which works with students of any type of disability to ensure they have equal access to classes and offers services to meet needs based on the student's situation.
